


Travelling




Game preparations

- Place the grey cards on top of the grey square, face down. Put the orange cards in the same way.
- Put the chips on the starting square and the dice on the table.

Instructions

- The player rolls the dice and moves forward on the board. If he goes to the gray square, he draws a card from the gray pile. The cards contain a question or a small task. Other players can ask more about it, or the group can also discuss the card question together - the most important thing is to talk a lot! Once the question is complete, the next player rolls the dice and acts in the same way.
- If a player goes to the orange square, they draw a card from the orange pile.
 Orange cards are related to the game: it may be that the player has to go backwards on the board, wait for his turn to throw, etc.
- The first player to reach the finish line is the winner.
